

CampusDoor Privacy Policy

(Effective Date: March 1, 2010)

We are committed to protecting the privacy of our customers' nonpublic personal information. Keeping your information secure and ensuring your understanding of how we collect, use and maintain such information is important to us. We have implemented privacy policies consistent with applicable law and regulatory requirements. We also have adopted policies and procedures designed to safeguard the security and confidentiality of your records and nonpublic personal information which are consistent with applicable law and regulatory requirements.

This Privacy Statement provides our customers ("you") with basic information relating to the types of nonpublic personal information we collect, how we use the nonpublic personal information we collect, how we disclose the nonpublic personal information we collect, and how we safeguard the nonpublic personal information we collect.

From time to time, we will update this Privacy Statement to reflect changes in our policies and practices. If you are still a customer of CampusDoor, you will receive written notification of any significant changes as required by law.

Our Collection of Nonpublic Personal Information

In order to provide the many services CampusDoor offers, we will need to obtain and maintain certain of your nonpublic personal information. We collect nonpublic personal information about you from the following sources:

- Information we receive from you on applications or other forms;
- Information about your transactions with us, our affiliates, or others; and
- Information we receive from consumer reporting agencies ("credit bureaus"), information clearing houses and governmental agencies.

Examples of information that we may ask you to provide may include (but not be limited to) the following:

- Name
- Date of Birth
- Mailing Address
- Social Security Number
- Email Address
- Employment Information

In order to maintain accurate information about you, please contact us if you change your address, telephone number or email address. You may contact us at 717.249.8800.

We may ask you for additional information so that we may confirm your identity. This additional personal information may be necessary to prevent fraud and to ensure that only you have access to your personal financial information. It is your responsibility to provide truthful and accurate nonpublic personal information and it is not our responsibility for any loss or damage that occurs if you fail to do so. It is also your responsibility to notify us if someone else has unauthorized access to your nonpublic personal information or has stolen your username or password. We may deny access to our products and services to any customer if a customer's identity is suspect. You may contact us at 717.249.8800.

The Collection and Use of Anonymous Data

Visitors can log on to our website to learn about CampusDoor, our products and services and find out how to contact us without providing any nonpublic personal information. We reserve the right to collect anonymous information when users access our website. The type of information that is gathered includes, but is not limited to, the date, time of day, which pages are visited and how much time is spent on the website. We only collect and use information about our users in the aggregate. The general information we collect enables us to serve our customers better by continually improving our site based on up-to-date usage patterns.

The Use of Cookies

We use standard web-based tracking technologies such as “cookies” and web server logs to collect information about how our site is used. A cookie is a small amount of data that is sent to your browser from a web server and stored on your computer's hard drive. Cookies do not collect or store personal information, except information you have knowingly provided.

Credit Bureau Reports

CampusDoor utilizes credit bureau reports in order to evaluate our customers' creditworthiness and to protect our customers from fraudulent conduct. Therefore, we may obtain a credit bureau report about you when you apply for or obtain any financial products and services from us, including the making or servicing of your student loan.

The following notice is provided to you pursuant to the Fair Credit Reporting Act: We may report information about your accounts to credit bureaus. Late payments, missed payments, or other defaults on your account may be reflected in your credit report. Pursuant to this Act, you have the right to ensure that the content of your credit report is accurate. If you believe that we have sent inaccurate information to the credit bureaus, please contact us at 717.249.8800.

Sharing of Personal Information

We do not disclose nonpublic personal information about our customers or our former customers to anyone, except as permitted by law or as otherwise disclosed in this Privacy Statement.

In order to provide you with access to a full range of products and services, we may share certain of your nonpublic personal information, including information about our transactions and experiences with you, with our affiliates in compliance with applicable law. An affiliate means any company that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with CampusDoor.

We may disclose the nonpublic personal information we collect, in whole or in part, to companies that perform marketing services on our behalf or to other financial institutions with whom we have joint marketing agreements. We may disclose all of your nonpublic personal information to unaffiliated third parties who perform services for us, and to unaffiliated third parties who perform services related to products and services that you already have or request from us. CampusDoor contractually requires all such third parties to maintain the confidentiality of any nonpublic personal information.

CampusDoor will disclose nonpublic personal information about you to non-affiliated third parties in response to a court order or other lawful request by a government or regulatory agency, to protect against misuse or unauthorized use of our site, and/or as we, in our sole discretion, believe necessary or appropriate to prevent fraud, defend our interests and protect our business assets, to limit our legal liability, to enforce or apply our rights and agreements, to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations or as otherwise permitted or required by law. We may also disclose nonpublic personal information to credit bureaus and similar organizations, and may exchange personal information with reference sources and clearinghouse services for purposes of fraud protection and credit reporting and verification. In addition, we may disclose and/or transfer your nonpublic personal information in the event of a change of control of our company, or a transfer of the business assets to which your nonpublic personal information relates.

Third Party Links

Our website may contain references, links and/or advertisements to other websites and organizations. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of any third parties or their websites which may differ from this Privacy Statement. We encourage you to review the privacy statement of each and every site that collects information from you in order to be informed of their privacy and security practices.

We will not sell or distribute any nonpublic personal information about you except in those circumstances listed above.

Promotional Materials That You May Receive

To advise our customers of special offers provided by CampusDoor, its affiliates or nonaffiliated third parties, we may send promotional materials concerning products and services that we believe might be of interest.

Security

We restrict access to your nonpublic personal information to only those authorized employees and agents who have a need to know such information to provide products or services to our customers. We maintain and monitor physical, electronic and procedural safeguards that comply with applicable law and regulatory requirements to guard your nonpublic personal information.
